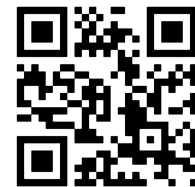

to stimulate knowledge transfer from universities and university colleges to companies and social profit organizations

IWT-TETRA PROJECT

for the creation of spin-off companies in Brussels by universities, university colleges, companies and collective research centers

INNOVIRIS SPIN-OFF IN BRUSSELS

for Ph.D.-projects in collaboration with a Flanders-based industrial partner

IWT-BAEKELAND

for postdoctoral researchers who aim at valorizing their research results in a (new) company

IWT-INNOVATION MANDATE

to attract excellent postdoctoral researchers to Flanders

FWO-PEGASUS MARIE CURIE FELLOWSHIP

for projects (pre- or postdoc) of Belgian/foreign researchers that contribute to the reflection on the development of the Brussels Capital Region (thematic calls)

INNOVIRIS-PROSPECTIVE RESEARCH FOR BRUSSELS

for Ph.D.-projects in collaboration with a Flanders-based industrial partner

IWT-BAEKELAND

for young researchers who wish to obtain a Ph.D. with economic/societal valorization potential

IWT-STRATEGIC RESEARCH PH.D. GRANT

FWO-FELLOWSHIP

- Ph.D. for young researchers who wish to obtain a Ph.D. (4 years of research)
- Clinical Ph.D. for clinical scientists who wish to work on their doctoral research (2 years, part-time)
- Special Ph.D. for persons not employed within scientific research to complete a Ph.D. and to obtain study leave from their current employer for this purpose (1 year)
- Postdoctoral Research, for researchers who have obtained a Ph.D. ((2x) 3 years of full-time research at postdoc level)
- Senior Clinical Research, for clinical scientists, particularly physicians-researchers, with a Ph.D. that are allowed to take a step back from their clinical activities to carry out research ((3x) 5 years, part-time)
- Pegasus Marie Curie to attract excellent postdoctoral researchers to Flanders

INNOVIRIS- BRAINS BACK TO BRUSSELS

to attract excellent postdoctoral researchers to Brussels

FWO-PROJECT

for research teams seeking to recruit scientists and technicians, to purchase equipment and to cover all sorts of operational costs for the execution of a research project

FWO-RESEARCH GRANT

in order to support young or established researchers (up to the maximum level of professor) in their work and, if necessary, in the purchase of small apparatus

INNOVIRIS-DOCTORIS

for Ph.D.-projects in collaboration with a Brussels-based industrial partner (at least 50% of the research time is spent in the company)

IWT-INNOVATION MANDATE

for postdoctoral researchers that aim at valorizing their research results in a (new) company

BELGIAN AMERICAN EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION (BAEF)

for fellowships for doctoral/postdoctoral research in the USA

IWT-APPLIED BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH

for non-profit R&D-actors, to execute late stage applied biomedical research
